### **Agenda Items:**

### **Approval of Last Months Minutes**

- Angela motioned to approve & Shazia 2nd the motion.

**Budget Update:** A number of items are expected to be different to budget - some of the main differences are:

- Tri-E-Thalon after taking into account costs being much lower than were budgeted for, net income was \$7,242 less than budgeted
- Spirit wear sales are expected to be approximately \$7,000 less than budgeted, however this means we have significant levels of stock so should need to purchase less next year
- Profits from dine-outs are expected to be approximately \$3,500, being \$2,750 higher than budgeted
- \$3,000 was in the budget in case the district required an external audit. At this point, there is no expectation that an external audit will be required so this reduces expected costs by \$3,000
- An amount of \$20,000 was set aside for a possible gift to Amador Elementary. As the final amount decided upon was \$10,000 then this reduces projected costs by \$10,000.

Before any funding requests discussed during the meeting, the projection for the end of the 2014/2015 school year is that the PFC should have approximately \$62,202 in the bank (if the spring fundraiser comes in on target). As long as fundraising for next school year is at a similar level to this year (adjusted for the number of families at Kolb), there should be adequate funds to run all core programs next year, and proceeds from the Spring Fundraiser could be used for any grade-specific funding requests that the teachers have for next year.
